## BACKGROUND

Cadets and Senior Members have been invited to Whiteman AFB to assist the Air Force Association (AFA) with their STEM Event that includes an officially sanctioned Soap Box Derby® race and work CAP recruiting booth and STEM display areas.

## CONCEPT OF OPERATIONS

CAP Units and Members are encouraged to form teams or join the Wing Composite Team with ASA and race in the All-American Soap Box Derby®. CAP members are also invited to assist with event support, judging, etc. MO Wing will also have STEM displays and a CAP Recruiting booth that we need assistance with.

## PREREQUISITES

Before 3 March 2017, all units must submit a roster of participating members that include their Social Security Numbers, Dates of Birth, and State ID/Driver's License Numbers (**16 and over**) Social Security numbers (all guests) (please note if DoD ID card or dependent ID card holder, then SSN# not needed), and Year, Make, Model, Color, Plate #, and issuing State vehicle information for the MSA and EAL. **US Citizens only. Senior members must have completed Level I and Cadets should have their Curry Award.**

## EXPECTATIONS

Participating Members may report Friday evening to S-6 (Wing HQ) to remain overnight (RON). An MSA will be in place to eat at the DFAC (Cash Only). Those not wishing to stay at S-6 may arrive at 0800.

## UNIFORM WEAR

All uniform combinations **MUST** be compliant IAW CAPM 39-1. Utility uniforms preferred.

## FUNDING/REIMBURSEMENT

Reimbursement for fuel or per diem must be approved by your unit finance committee.

## MEALS

DFAC will be available, as well as local eateries. Be prepared to pay cash. Recommend factoring \$8 per meal.

## SUPPORTING THE DERBY

All CAP Members attending are required to support CAP Operations at the All-American Soap Box Derby® and CAP Areas. Time will be allocated to spectate along with work/rest cycles.

## REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

Cadets must have a [CAPE 32 Cadet Activity Permission Slip](#) and **ALL Members** must carry a [CAPE 161 Emergency Information Form](#).
